Here are a few FAQ's about volunteering & visiting:

> What if I have not completed a background check?

You may visit with your child only when in the school

> What if someone shows up like an aunt/grandparent, what is the policy?

If they have not done an I-chat, they are not allowed to volunteer.

> What if a parent shows up and wants to bring along a friend who is not on the list, what is the policy?

If they have not done an I-chat, they are not allowed to volunteer.

> What if a parent visits at lunch or on the playground?

Parents who wish to eat lunch with their students must sign in at the office and wear a visitor tag.

They can only eat with their child at a separate, designated table.

Parents are no longer allowed to be on the playground.
